



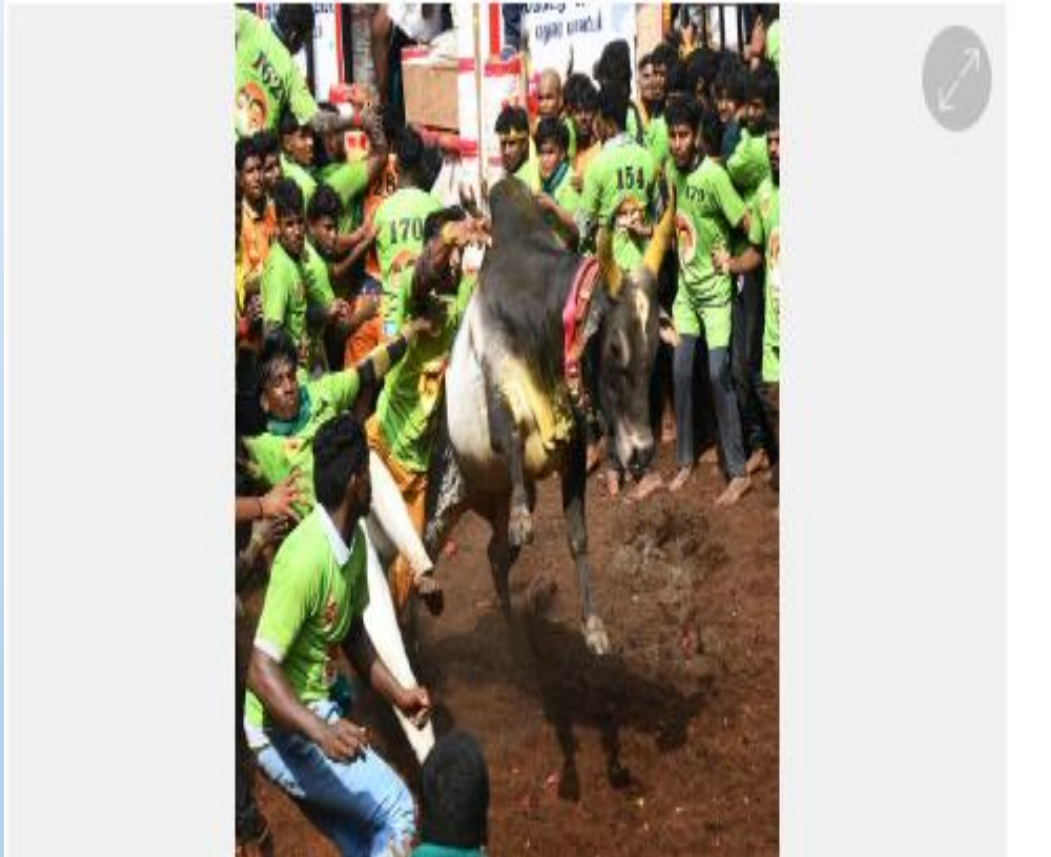

Greenland has lost 20% more ice than previously thought, says study

Climate change has caused Greenland's ice sheet to lose 20% more ice than previously thought, according to research published in the journal Nature.

- **Greenland Ice Sheet**, the single ice sheet or glacier covering about 80 percent of the island of Greenland and the largest ice mass in the Northern Hemisphere, globally second in size to only the ice mass that covers Antarctica.

ASER 2023 findings: 'In Cooch Behar, 79% 14 to 18-yr olds unable to do basic arithmetic'

At 61.3 per cent, more than half of 14 to 18 year old youths in the district could not read simple sentences in English.



- The Annual Status of Education Report (ASER), titled “Beyond Basics”, was released
- It involved a survey by the civil society organisation Pratham among rural students aged 14 to 18.
- The household survey, conducted in 28 districts across 26 States, assessed the foundational reading and arithmetic abilities of 34,745 students.
- It discussed the activities students are engaged in, their basic and applied reading and maths abilities and digital awareness and skills.
- Overall, 86.8% of 14- to 18-year-olds are enrolled in an educational institution. T

Ram Mandir Pran Pratishtha: What exactly is pran pratishtha, and how is it carried out? How can the worshipper impart prana, or life, to the worshipped? We explain



Pran Pratishtha, in literal terms, means 'establishment of life force' or basically 'infusing life' into something.

In Hinduism, Pran Pratishtha is a sacred ceremony where the divine essence, referred to as prana, is invoked and transferred into an idol or image of a deity in a temple or at home.

According to traditions, beliefs and scriptures, it is this process that transforms the normal murti or object into a living representation of the deity to be worshipped.
