Use Chabahar port, India tells Central Asian countries






Location: It is a seaport in **Chabahar** located in **southeastern Iran**, on the **Gulf of Oman**.

EU rules policing digital content kick in today; harsh punishments for violation

The new rules kicked in last year for large platforms such as Facebook and TikTok

- It is designed to keep users safe online and stop the spread of harmful content that's either illegal or violates a platform's terms of service, such as promotion of genocide or anorexia.
- It require the companies to perform risk management, conduct external and independent auditing, share data with authorities and researchers and adopt a code of conduct.
- It also looks to protect Europeans' fundamental rights like privacy and free speech.
- The DSA prohibits targeting vulnerable categories of people, including children, with ads.

PM scheme has put end to exploitation of street vendors: Minister Hardeep Puri

The programme was attended by Delhi Lieutenant Governor V K Saxena; Minister of State for Culture and External Affairs Meenakshi Lekhi; among others.

- The scheme is a Central Sector Scheme i.e. fully funded by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs
- The PM Street Vendor's AtmaNirbharNidhi (PM SVANidhi) Scheme, launched on June 1, 2020, is a micro credit scheme for urban street vendors that aims to provide collateral-free working capital loans up to ₹50,000. Under the scheme regular repayments are incentivized with a 7% interest subsidy and digital transactions are rewarded with cashback up to ₹1,200 per year.

ISRO's 'naughty boy' rocket to launch India's latest weather satellite today

GSLV-F14 to lift off at 5.35 pm; INSAT-3DS to have a mission life of 10 years

INSAT-3DS will be launched by the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO).

About INSAT-3DS

INSAT-3DS Satellite is a **follow-on mission** of Third Generation Meteorological Satellite from Geostationary Orbit.

Launch vehicle: The GSLV aims at deploying the INSAT-3DS meteorological satellite into the Geosynchronous Transfer Orbit (GTO).

Subsequent orbit-raising maneuvers will ensure that the satellite is positioned in a Geo-stationary Orbit. It is fully funded by the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES). It is designed for enhanced meteorological observations and monitoring of land and ocean surfaces for weather forecasting and disaster warning.

ISRO successfully de-orbits remote sensing satellite Cartosat-2

The latest Cartosat-2 (generation II) satellite to de-orbit was launched in January 2007

Cartosat-2 Series Satellite is the primary satellite carried by PSLV-C40. This remote sensing satellite is similar in configuration to earlier satellites in the series and is intended to augment data services to the users. Cartosat-2, ISRO's first satellite in the second generation of high-resolution imaging satellites was launched on January 10, 2007. It weighed 680 kg at launch and operated in a sunsynchronous polar orbit at an altitude of 635 km. Until 2019, it provided high-resolution imagery for urban planning. Initially, Cartosat-2 was expected to take about 30 years to naturally de-orbit. However, ISRO opted to lower its perigee using leftover fuel to comply with international guidelines on space debris mitigation

OpenAI Sora: Imagine being able to create a short or long video just by typing out a description of what you want to see. The makers of ChatGPT have given a first glimpse of how it can be possible.



- OpenAI, the creator of the revolutionary chatbot <u>ChatGPT</u>, has unveiled a new generative artificial intelligence (GenAI) model that can convert a text prompt into video
- The model, called Sora, can generate videos up to a minute long while maintaining visual quality and adherence to the user's prompt,
- Sora is capable of creating "complex scenes with multiple characters, specific types of motion, and accurate details of the subject and background,
