
→ **WHAT IS A GOOD FP?**

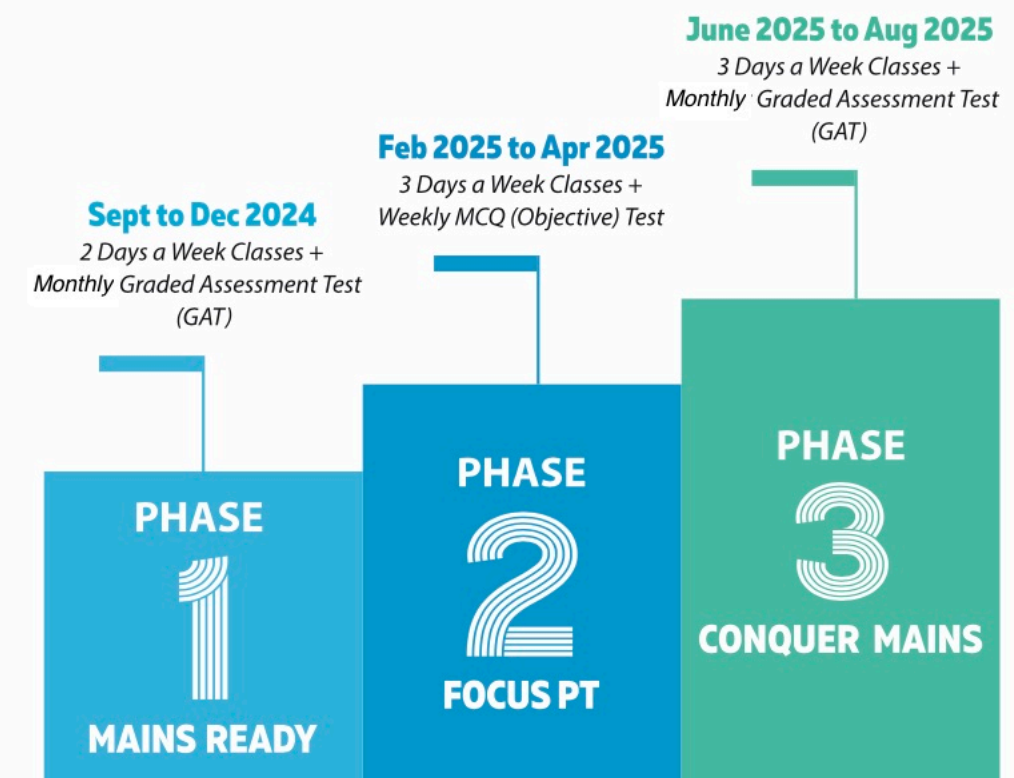

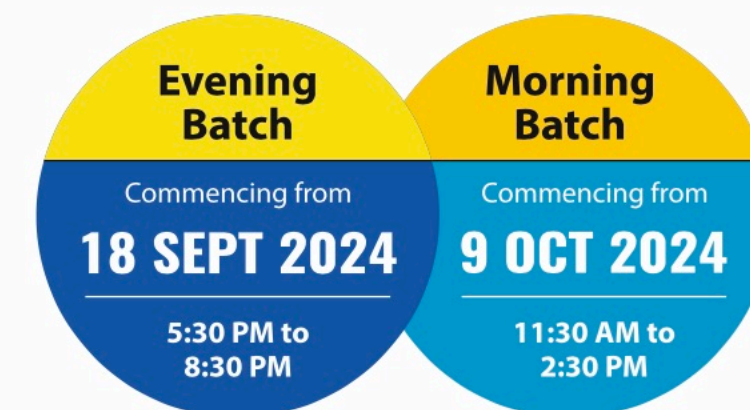
However, students often struggle with information overload, unable to discern what is relevant. These classes emphasize **decluttered** information and provide UPSC-specific content.
